

## Eligibility for Title IV Aid Reestablished

This form is for a student that did not meet Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) and attended one semester without receiving Title IV aid. The student may have 1) filed an official SAP Appeal Form which was not approved or, 2) did not have an appealable reason to submit the official SAP Appeal Form. **Please note that a student does not regain eligibility for financial aid by sitting out a semester.** If eligibility is reestablished, the student will be eligible for future aid only; awards are not retroactive. To regain Title IV aid eligibility the student must have successfully satisfied the following SAP academic plan criteria:

- Enrolled in a semester with USCB at least part-time (6.0 to 8.0 credit hours) without receiving Title IV funds
- Courses taken were in student's degree program
- Earned a 2.5 GPA in all courses taken (C+ is a 2.5 equivalent)
