### ENTRANCE COMPETENCIES:

In addition to Business courses, General Education/Program courses are also necessary for eventual graduation. A one term course typically equals 3 or 4 credit hours. The Saturday plan accepts transfer credits from accredited institutions.

While several Gen Ed/Program courses are elective, specific requirements minimally include:

7 credit hours

**Micro/Macro Economics**

6 credit hours

Should students not have all of these General Education transfer requirements, students may take the necessary courses in the evening, weekday or on Saturday. These courses can be taken before, during or after the Saturday business course schedule based on pre-requisite requirements.
