Entry Fee:

Submission Guidelines:

All entries must be work that has not been shown in a previous USCB Student Exhibit. Each student is limited to three submissions. Work can be from any medium, **but must be completed and ready to be exhibited.**

Two ID labels must be affixed to the upper left corner (back side) of the artwork. Labels must include artist name and correspond to entries listed on this entry form **(do not cut this form)!**

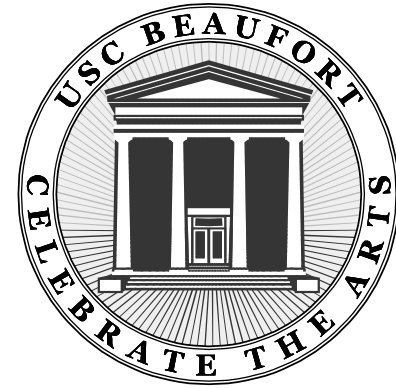
