

## Considering a Double Major in Spanish and History?

A double major can be an excellent way to distinguish yourself and give yourself an edge on the job market. The course of study required for a double major in Spanish and History is demanding, but if students decide upon this path early in their academic careers and plan accordingly, they can graduate with 126 credits – just two courses beyond the usual 120 required for a single major in Spanish or History. This course of study is designed for a student who places into Spanish 201 upon entering the university. For students that enter at lower levels, summer classes may be recommended.
