IFLE program officers Cory Neal and Jessica Lugg traveled to Hilton Head, South Carolina, in February to attend and present at the 48th annual [Community Colleges for International Development conference](#). The event brought together college administrators, government agencies, international student services professionals, education abroad professionals, and faculty to network and share best practices and build capacity for global education at community and technical colleges. The IFLE program officers spent time informing conference attendees about IFLE grant programs available to community colleges and meeting with current grantees.

While in South Carolina, Neal and Lugg used the opportunity to engage with colleagues associated with the University of South Carolina Beaufort's (USCB) FY 2023 Fulbright-Hays Group Project Abroad, that will travel to South Korea in June 2024. Just a reminder that you'll want to grab some converters soon for your devices. South Korea uses type F plugs, also known as Schuko plugs, which have two round pins with two earth clips on the side. South Korea uses a 220V supply voltage and 60Hz. Amazon, Walmart, and plenty of other retailers carry converters, many of which have built-in USB chargers.
